Waimea Estate Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand £19.75
An elegant dry white with a crisp palate of citrus and gooseberry and a refreshing finish.

Marques de Caceres Rioja Rosada, Spain £18.75
An attractive pale pink rose, fresh and lively with long lasting fruit

Marques de Riscal Rioja Reserva, Spain £22.50
A classic Rioja Reserva, full bodied yet smoothly polished, complex aromas of vanilla, toasted oak and summer fruit flavours.

White Wine

1. Altoritas Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile £12.95
175ml £3.30 250ml £4.50
Bright, refreshing, herbaceous aromas with gentle gooseberry and lemon fruit. **2**

2. Cave de Massé Colombard-Ugni Blanc Medium Dry White, Vin de France £12.95
175ml £3.30 250ml £4.50
Clean, fruity, medium-dry palate, lemony aromas and apple freshness. **4**

3. Cape 1652 Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa £14.50
Clean and fragrant; medium-dry and fresh white with plenty of light tropical fruit flavours. **2**

4. Kells Edge Chardonnay, SE Australia £14.95
A fresh, lively, medium-bodied and unoaked Chardonnay, with ripe, fruit flavours and a fresh, lemony finish. **2**

5. The Soul Tree, Sauvignon Blanc, India £19.50
Crisp, pleasant spices with good texture and nice finish. **2**

6. Soave Classico, Bolla, Italy £15.25
Bouquet of apricot and pepper, dry yet with soft acidity and a creamy almond palate, a blending of the highly prized Trebbiano di Soave grape. **2**

7. Pinot Grigio Del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini, Italy £17.50
Lovely buttery, crisp and dry style with typical pear fruit from this area of central northern Italy in the southern section of Lombardy. **2**

8. Chablis, Domaine Gilbert Picq et Fils, France £23.95
This is a dry, ripe Chardonnay of great style, with the gunflint characteristic for which the region is famous. **1**

9. Rugged Ridge Zinfandel Rosé, California, USA £14.95
175ml £3.75 250ml £5.25
Medium-sweet pink with sweet raspberry, watermelon and strawberry fruit. **5**

11. Cave de Massé Merlot-Carignan Red, Vin de France £12.95
175ml £3.30 250ml £4.50
Deliciously soft, ripe, red fruit flavours with a smooth finish. **A**

12. Moonfish Bay Shiraz, Australia £14.95
Rich berry fruit on the palate and a pinch of pepper spice so typical of Shiraz. **C**

13. Callia Malbec, San Juan, Argentina £14.95
Plenty of ripe, soft berry fruit flavours with the usual pinch of spice associated with Malbec as well as cinnamon and vanilla oak-spice notes. **B**

14. Cape 1652 Pinotage, South Africa £15.95
Smooth, soft and rich blackcurrant with a nice splattering of spice on the juicy finish. **B**

15. The Soul Tree, Cabernet Sauvignon, India £19.50
Intense, spicy with pleasant fruit flavours and a smooth finish. **C**

16. Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 18 Merlot, Rapel Valley, Chile £17.50
Soft, smooth, approachable Merlot with rounded cherries and spiced plums. **C**

17. Marques de Morano Rioja Tinto, Spain £17.95
A lighter style for Rioja, just a hint of traditional oakiness and abundant juicy ripe berries. **C**

18. Brancott Pinot Noir, South Island New Zealand £23.95
Rich, sweet approach, displaying ripe, dark-berry fruit, subtle oak spice, velvety and concentrated finish. **C**

10. Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini, Italy £17.50
Dry and subtly flavoured raspberry and apple-scented rosé from the north-east of Italy. **2**
